

## **WORLD MASTERS POLICY**

### **DEAR PLAYERS & VISITORS,**

#### **Welcome to the 2024 World Masters tournaments!**

The World Masters prescribes the mandatory rules of admission and conduct Applicable to the World Masters (hereinafter referred to as the Event), organised by World Darts federation and the Hungarian Darts Federation ( WDF & MDSZ).

The Policy and Rules set out the rights and obligations stemming from the legal relationship entered into between Organisers and persons entering the Tournaments (/ World Open /World Championship Qualifiers/ IDF World Ranking) for both - Players and Visitors.

Event venue: H-1141 Budapest, Istvánmezei út 3-5, Gerevich Aladár Sportcsarnok (Gerevich Aladár Sport hall)

Event dates: October 9-13, 2024

online registration for the competition is based on WDF eligibility list and can be done via [www.dartstours.hu](http://www.dartstours.hu).

Opening of the Event venue: 9 October, 2024, 09.00

Closing of the Event venue: 13 October , 2024, 21.00

Upon arrival, accreditation is mandatory for all Players based on the online registration- list.

Accreditation is done at the Gerevich Aladár Sports Hall Main Entrance.

Opening Accreditation procedure: 9 October, 2024, 09.00

Closing of accreditation: 13 October 2024 12.00

## **I. EVENT ADMISSIONS GENERAL RULES**

1. Players following Accreditation procedure receive a dedicated wristband to and this it shall require the verification of personal identity by a personal identification document containing a photograph of the document-holder.
2. The Organisers shall read, record, store, and manage the data of the personal identification document pursuant to the applicable data handling authorisation and/or policies. If the Player or Visitor refuses to comply with those written in the previous sentence, then Organisers shall be entitled to invalidate the wristband without any obligation to refund the purchase price, and refuse entry for the Event.
3. Visitors are required to wear their wristbands for the duration of their validity.
4. Players' eligibility for alcoholic beverages is also determined by the wristband (underage competitors will be issued with a different coloured wristband). Wristbands are non-transferable.
5. Organisers may refuse entry of the Event if the Visitor is in a condition which endangers the civilized arrangement of the Event or the safety of the other

Visitors or assets. Also may be refused entry of the Event if the Visitor has the symptoms of the pandemic/epidemic disease.

6. Organisers avails itself of the assistance of a private security service on the rules of activities of on the rules governing the activities of private security services . Prior to the entry to the Event and as well as at any spot of the venue of the Event, Organisers or the security service may check the clothing and packages of the Visitors. The security service may refuse the intake of forbidden items or the entry to the Event. The security service shall be entitled to ban or refuse the entry of the person infringing the Policy, provided that such person is not ceasing the infringement upon request. in some cases. The entry to the Event may be refused especially in the events determined by this Visitor Policy and furthermore, if the person willing to entry.
7. In order to ensure the safety of the Event, Organisers reserves the right to restrict the types of items and devices which may be brought inside the venue. Accordingly, bringing the following in particular to the Event is prohibited: narcotics, pyrotechnic devices, glass objects, tools containing explosive, poisonous or flammable materials, knives over 8 cm blades, gas sprays, expandable batons, metal chains over 50 cm in length, throwing stars, slingshots and other items posing a special threat to public safety as defined in relevant laws and regulations (currently: Government Decree No. 175/2003 of 28 October 2003).
8. Competitor / Visitor is not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages into the Event area. He/she may bring 2 litres of mineral water / soft drinks per person per day for personal needs.
9. Visitors are entitled to bring food or tobacco products for their own consumption, but are not entitled to bring commercial quantities of such products into the Event area.
10. Visitors under the age of 12 may enter the Event area only with an adult companion of legal age.
11. Entry in a vehicle to the area of the Event is not permitted without a permit issued by Organisers. Those holding a vehicle permit are also obliged to follow all traffic rules and regulations.
- 12. Organisers recommend using forms of public transport and taxi services to access the Event.**
13. In addition to service dogs as defined by law, guide dogs and police dogs, only pets generally considered to be tame and posing no hazard to the life, safety and health of Visitors and others may be brought inside the Event venue, free of charge, when on a leash and accompanied by their owner (typically, admissible pets include dogs, ferrets, certain types of rodents, etc.).
- 14. Players/Visitors are, however, advised not to bring their pets to the Event.**
- 15. Pets are not allowed on the race hall. The only exceptions to this prohibition are assistance dogs.**

## II. RULES OF CONDUCT

1. Visitors are required to abide by general norms and in accordance with relevant legal regulations, the Policy. Players/ Visitors are required to refrain from all
2. actions, statements or behaviour which endangers the life, health or physical well-being of others or which may violate others' personal rights. Visitors to the Event are required to pay special attention to the protection of natural resources and must refrain from harming these natural resources.
3. Organiser asks Players/Visitors to use the waste collection bins for the disposal of garbage and to pay attention to dispose the garbage in the appropriate compartment for each waste type. Recyclable PET and CAN can place into the dedicated REPONT container. This is also a way to support the Hungarian Youth Darts.
4. The Player/Visitor, infringing Policy and not ceasing the infringement upon request, may be removed from the territory of the Event. The Player/Visitor may be removed from
5. the Event especially in the events determined by this Policy and furthermore, if (i) disobeys the instructions given by Organisers; (ii) endangers the life, physical safety, property rights or assets of another person; pollutes or threatens the environment;(iv) behaves rowdy or in a way that serves as a basis for the action of the police; (v) incites against other social groups or causes unrest by his/her aggressive behaviour; (vi) fails to remove a banned item from the Event venue despite a prior warning; (vii) has entered into the Event at another spot than the entrance or has been removed from the Event previously; (viii) entered into an area closed for Visitors or has tried such entry, including the entry or trying to enter into a spot where he/she is not allowed to entry by his/her wristband ; (ix) is not able to certify his or her age by ID card or other authentic personal document; (x) has been banned from the Event.
6. In this case No refund of the Registration Fee or Entrance Fee may be claimed by anyone who has been removed from the Event.
7. Players/Visitors acknowledge that Organisers, its Contracted Partners as authorised by Organisers Contributors, and members of the press (in accordance with the stipulations of special agreements concluded with them), as well as other Visitors and other third parties, may produce sound and image recordings of the Event.
8. Visitors, however, may only be named in such recordings with their express permission. Visitors considered public figures may be named without their permission. Those making recordings according to the above rules shall gain transferrable and exclusive usage rights that are unrestricted in time, geographical location and form of usage

9. Players/Visitors to the Event, by virtue of their participation at the Event, give express permission to the recording and publication of their image, likeness and actions. Organisers are entitled to utilise, use (especially for the promotion of the Event), duplicate, publish, transpose, make public, transmit to the public and distribute such recordings of the Visitor - including the case if Organisers utilises or uses recordings made by other Players/Visitor(s) - without providing any compensation to them. Players/Visitors expressly acknowledge that Organisers may record the Event, games may copy the recordings and distribute them, may broadcast them or otherwise make them public and may do so repeatedly, any other means (for example, social media), such that members of the public can individually select the place and time of access.
10. No business, commercial or advertising activity may be conducted at the Event – including the area in front of the gates of the Event – without advance written authorisation from Organisers.
11. No alcoholic beverages may be served to minors under the age of eighteen (18) and to intoxicated individuals by any vendor at the Event.
12. In order to minimise waste, in case of measured beverages, a system of reusable cup is implemented at the Event. The goal of the reusable cup system is to achieve that the Players/Visitors use cups for multiple use at the Event. Within the frames of this, the Visitor purchases a reusable cup which, after consumption, may be switched to another reusable cup. The usage fee is HUF 800 of the reusable cup 0.5 (hereinafter Reusable Cup), the usage fee of the reusable shot-glass is HUF 400. If the Visitor is not willing to use the reusable cup at the Event temporarily, the Reusable Cup will be replaced by 1 (one) WM key-ring token. The token may be exchanged to a reusable cup again at the Event.

### **III. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

1. Visitors may only enter the Event at their own risk.
1. Organisers may be held responsible exclusively for intentional breaches of contract caused by Organisers or for breaches of contract resulting in loss of life, physical well-being or health, and expressly excludes any liability beyond the statutory rights of the Visitor with regard to any other damage event.
2. Organisers are not required to cancel the Event if there is bad weather
3. Organisers reserve the right to change the Event line-up.
4. During the Tournament Dedicated Darts sports exhibition and sales point will be available. Also Buffet/catering unit working at the venue.
5. Requests, questions and comments related to these services can be addressed to the service provider.
6. The Event does not operate luggage storage or safe deposit facilities at the venue.

7. The VIP parts of the Event are not continuously open, their opening and closing times may be determined by Organisers depending on the number of people interested.
8. Please watch out for one another and for yourselves!
